

Job Description – Installer I

OVERVIEW:

This is an entry level position. The Installer I works in the field as part of the installation team on commercial projects. The objective of this position is to use their skills to install acoustical ceiling tile, wall panels and wall protection products per the product specifications. An Installer is expected to be proficient in the techniques required to cut tiles on a basic project. As more experience is gained and advanced techniques are learned the opportunity to work on specialty work may become available as business allows.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The responsibilities of the position include, but are not limited to, the following:

Installer:

- Learn the techniques of making various types of cuts in a variety of tile types
- Learn the operation of various tools to accomplish a quality installation
- Learn the techniques and best practices to ensure quality workmanship
- Learn the techniques and best practices to ensure highest level of productivity
- Support the installation team by positioning materials as required
- Ensure the working area is clean and free of debris
- Follow all of the company's policies
- Perform all work in accordance with safety rules and requirements

ON THE JOB TRAINING:

In this position the candidate will receive on the job training in:

- Use of basic hand tools
- Laser Level
- Power tools (i.e. drills and saws)
- Ramset Viper Gun – license required
- Scaffolds
- Lifts – training required
- Commercial safety protocols

DESIRED SKILLS & EXPERIENCE**EDUCATION:**

High School or Vocational School graduate. Understanding of construction concepts and techniques. OSHA 10 hour preferred.

SKILLS:

General carpentry skills. Basic math skills a must. Ability to find the center of a room and calculate measurements using a tape and laser level.

REQUIREMENTS:

This is an entry level position, no acoustical ceiling experience is required. Must have a driver's license and a dependable vehicle to get to jobs. Must be able to travel to jobsites in the geographic area from Boston south to the Cape & Islands, southwest to northern Rhode Island, north to Worcester and back to Boston. Have own tools (see Equipment & Tools attached). Must have a positive attitude, be able to make good decisions, work well with others, be hardworking, conscientious and have clean professional appearance. Position requires lifting and carrying of materials weighing approximately 50 lbs. and climbing ladders and scaffolding.
