

Job Description – Mechanic I

OVERVIEW:

The Mechanic works in the field as part of the installation team on commercial projects. A Mechanic Installer is expected to be proficient in the techniques required in the installation of grid and tiles in a self-directed manner.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The responsibilities of the position include, but are not limited to, the following:

Mechanic Installer:

- Proficient at installing whole and cut tiles of all varieties into grid systems
- Independently perform 15/16" basic grid layouts that are straight, square and level
- Perform complex grid layouts with some assistance
- Efficiently utilize materials to reduce waste
- Utilize various tools to accomplish a quality installation
- Utilize techniques and best practices to ensure quality workmanship
- Utilize techniques and best practices to ensure productivity
- Position materials where necessary as required
- Ensure the working area is clean and free of debris at the end of each shift
- Understand and follow safety rules and procedures
- Participate in safety and company meetings as required
- Complete paperwork as required for company purposes (i.e. timesheets, material forms, etc.)
- Follow all of the company's policies
- Perform all work in accordance with safety rules and requirements

DESIRED SKILLS & EXPERIENCE**EDUCATION:**

High School or Vocational School graduate. Understanding of construction concepts and techniques. OSHA 10 hour required.

SKILLS:

In this position the candidate is expected to have experience with the following:

- Use of basic hand tools
- Laser Level
- Power tools (i.e. drills and saws)
- Ramset Viper Gun – license required
- Scaffolds
- Lifts – valid training card
- Commercial safety protocols
- Basic Math Skills
- Ability to find the center of a room and calculate measurements using a tape and laser level.

REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates for this position possess a minimum of 3 years of experience in acoustical ceilings installation. Must have a driver's license and a dependable vehicle to get to jobs. Be able to travel to job sites at various locations in and around the Eastern Massachusetts area. Have own tools (see Equipment & Tools attached). Must have a positive attitude, be able to make good decisions, work well with others, be hardworking, conscientious and have clean professional appearance. Position requires lifting and carrying of materials weighing approximately 50 lbs. and climbing ladders and scaffolding.
